

PREP/ONE









ONE/TWO






We are so happy to be back for an awesome term two in the grade 1/2 classroom. This week we have been reading books with humorous characters, we have noticed some of the characteristics that make them funny, such as the way they are depicted in illustrations and the way they talk. We have been creating our own stories with characters that we have made up. We have also been making sure we include a problem and solution in our stories.

In maths we love doing our daily slides each day! We have been concentrating on addition and even two digit addition. We have also been looking at patterns with our new teacher Mrs Connolly who will be joining us each Friday from now on as Mrs M gets some well deserved rest.

We have started the term by exploring rules and laws, who makes them, and why we have them. We have been reading fiction stories about rules and laws, and there have been lots of great discussions about what happens when we don't have rules or laws in our community. In UFLI we have learned about /ph/, /wh/, /ng/ and /nk/. We have been learning about pronouns and prepositions, and learning how to use them in our writing. In maths we have been learning about the language of chance, and we've particularly focusing developing really strong strategies for solving two-digit addition and subtraction problems. We are looking forward to our Special Ladies Day next Friday, and showing our special people around our classroom. We hope you can make it!






























THREE/FOUR








What a great start to Term 2!

Happy Birthday to our wonderful students who are celebrating their birthdays over the next fortnight!







Friday, May 12th

This Term we have also welcomed a new face into our OSHClub community, we look forward to welcoming many more faces as the term progresses.




